Type of Play:

This event has two tournaments running concurrently. An LLESA Golf Networking Group tournament, with prizes, and a NCGA qualifying tournament in which winning teams can represent our club in the 2025 NCGA Four-Ball tournament.

The format is 2-Person Best Ball (2-person teams, using the low individual net score, on each hole). Closest to the pin prizes on all par 3 holes.

The NCGA qualifier will cap the handicap index 18.4 for men and 25.4 for women. Players with handicap indexes higher than that can compete but must use the capped handicap index. The LLESA Golf NG tournament does not have a handicap limit.

Player handicap allowance is 85%.

In order to be eligible to represent our club in the NCGA Four-Ball tournament:

- you must be a full (not associate) member of LLESA Golf NG
- you must have an established handicap index
- you must have played in at least two LLESA tournaments in the past 12 months
